

- Sweep, don't hose, your driveway or other paved surfaces
- Consider using downspout extenders to direct water onto your lawn instead of pavement

Veterans Day is November 11.

Veterans Day originated as "Armistice Day" on Nov. 11, 1919, the first anniversary of the end of World War I. Congress passed a resolution in 1926 for an annual observance, and Nov. 11 became a national holiday beginning in 1938. Unlike Memorial Day, Veterans Day pays tribute to all American veterans—living or dead—but especially gives hanks to living veterans who served their country honorably during war or peacetime.

There are several options to honor our veterans this Veterans Day. You can participate in a local Veterans Day Ceremony. The Barrow County Veterans Day Ceremony will be held on Saturday, November 11 at 11AM in Jug Tavern Park in Winder. Honoring veterans and their families, free lunch will be served immediately following the ceremony. The public is invited to lunch for a small donation of your choice to the Barrow County Veterans Resource Center. The Winder Barrow High School and Apalachee High School bands will perform.
